 lesson that we would <u>highly recommend</u>. This lesson is less than an hour long and will help give
 you the basics you need to have a great time skiing or snowboarding.
- Perfect North does allow outside food and drink in the lodge; however, there are many food
 options available in the lodge itself. A normal meal will range from \$8 to \$10.
- At the end of the night, we will meet back at the established table at 9:15 pm. From there we
 will load the bus and travel home.
- When we are 20 min away from the school, a remind will be sent out notifying parents and students and allowing non-driving students to arrange for their pickup.
- We will arrive back at WHS around 10:30 pm, where everyone will be released to their cars or parent by a chaperone who will be present until every member is on their way.
